



- Introducing the Philip Goodeve-Docker Memorial Prize, created in memory of his son, Philip.
- Philip gave his life to save that of his friends, Rowan and Andy, during their endeavour to cross the Greenland Ice Sheet to raise funds for the QNI in 2013, 'The pilots, engineers, doctors, nurses all volunteered to be part of the helicopter rescue mission. Unbelievable courage as the conditions were so difficult for a helicopter to fly. It was the worst storm in Greenland history. Rowan and Andy survived for 45 hours. Tragically, Philip died two hours before they were rescued.'
- Mr Goodeve-Docker congratulated the prize winners on their achievement and paid testament to them as they embark on their careers as specialist practitioners in District Nursing.






