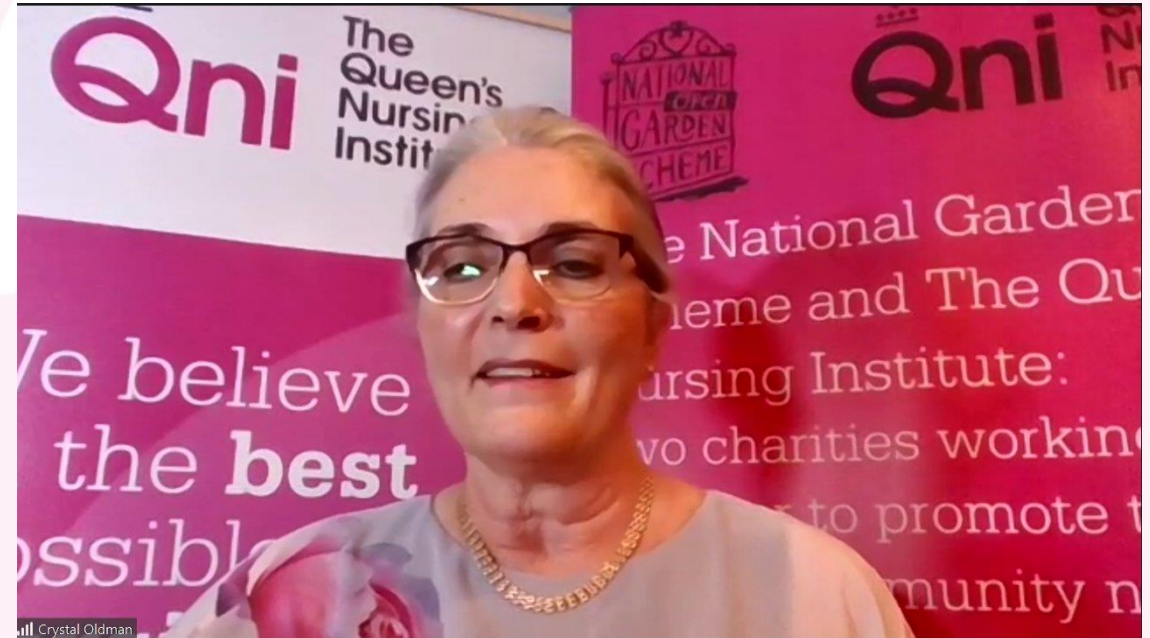

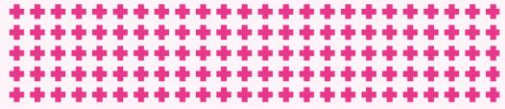

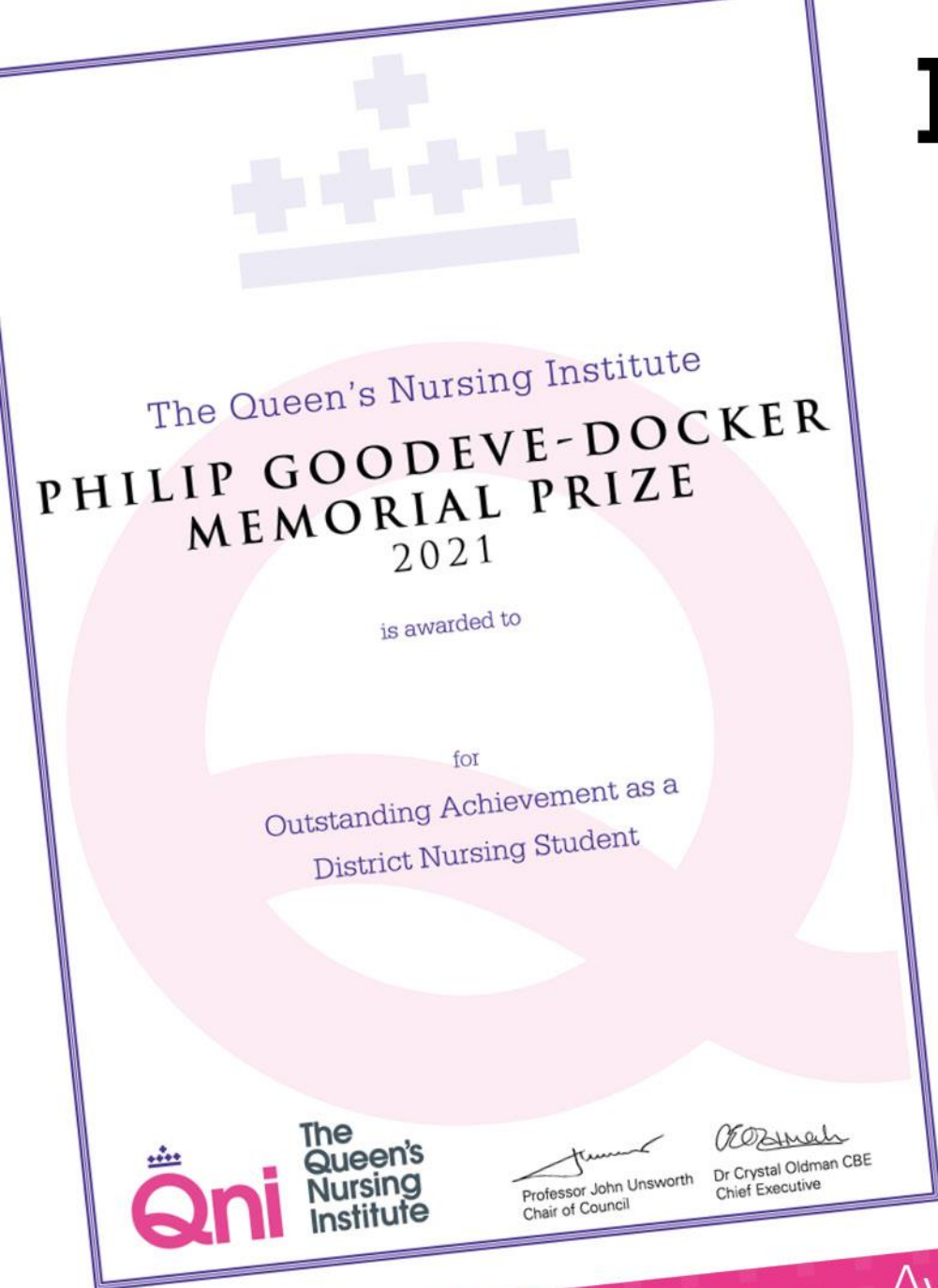

- Introducing the Philip Goodeve-Docker Memorial Prize, created in memory of his son, Philip.
- Philip gave his life to save that of his friends, Rowan and Andy, during their endeavour to cross the Greenland Ice Sheet to raise funds for the QNI in 2013, *'The pilots, engineers, doctors, nurses all volunteered to be part of the helicopter rescue mission. Unbelievable courage as the conditions were so difficult for a helicopter to fly. It was the worst storm in Greenland history. Rowan and Andy survived for 45 hours. Tragically, Philip died two hours before they were rescued.'*
- Mr Goodeve-Docker congratulated the prize winners on their achievement and paid testament to them as they embark on their careers as specialist practitioners in District Nursing.
